



GREAT TRUTH TWO

God Is Our Creator and the Creator of the Entire Universe

God is the One who has made us. He has also created the world in which we live. We will never understand who we are or where we are going unless we know who our Creator is. When we truly understand that, we will have a new sense of awe and wonder—not only about God, but also about ourselves and the world we live in.

Though There Is Only One True God. This God Exists in Three Persons—the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit						

Many people in the world believe there is only one true God. However, the Bible teaches us something about this God that we cannot learn anywhere else. The Bible teaches that this one God has existed from all eternity in three "persons" known as God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. This teaching of one God in three persons (called the Holy Trinity) is very difficult for us to understand or explain. However, we accept it as the way God has made Himself known to us.

In Lesson 5 we will study about God the Son who came to earth as Jesus Christ. In Lesson 8 we will learn more about God the Holy Spirit. In this lesson we simply note that the Father is God, the Son is God and the Holy Spirit is God—and that these three are the one true God
