This is a story of tragic loss and blessed gain. This is the story of John Turnipseed, who spent his youth fighting disadvantages and hardship, learning life by making the greatest mistakes. Mistakes that cost him a life he created and ten years in prison, after which he came into the Fathering Center at Urban Ventures and now has built a program that reaches 600 men and 200 women. This is a story of truth.

New Lesson Format: What You Need to Know

Crossroads continues to adapt to changes in how mail is handled in correctional facilities. Starting this summer, you will notice a shift from the lesson booklets you currently receive to lessons formatted on standard 8.5-by-11-inch sheets of paper.

Many facilities across the country are now scanning incoming mail for distribution. However, some scanning services struggle to accurately process Crossroads' current lesson booklets, leading some facilities to stop accepting our lessons altogether. By switching to these reformatted lessons, we hope to reach more students who have faced challenges in receiving their lessons.

While the new format will look a little different, the content remains unchanged. We are committed to making the reformatted lessons visually appealing, although they will now feature black and white artwork instead of color. This adjustment is necessary because scanning services typically cannot handle color artwork.

Scripture Reading and Prayer Guide: The Book of Acts

This June and July, we will study the book of Acts (also known as the Acts of the Apostles). During the earliest years of Christianity, Christians faced severe persecution in Jerusalem, but God opened many doors for the apostles to bring the good news of the Gospel to the nations. We hope you are encouraged and strengthened as you see how God shared His love with the world through His apostles despite very challenging circumstances.

Facts about the book of Acts include:

- It is the only biblical history of the Church, picking up where the Gospels end.
- It spans about thirty years, from the resurrection of Jesus around 30 AD to the early 60s AD.
- It details the spread of the Gospel and the growth of the Church from Jerusalem to Rome.
- It begins with the outpouring of God's promised Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost.
- It records the conversion and ministry of Paul, the apostle to the Gentiles.
